High Point Program Points Explanation

Revised 2017

Points: Points will be awarded in the inverse order to the number of horses in your class (up to 5) with the exception of dressage and sport horse in hand, which will be awarded based off of your score. Championship class points are **doubled**, Regional points are **doubled** and top 5's are counted as 3rd place, National points are **tripled** and top 10's count as 3rd place.

All points will be awarded to the horse except in the following categories: Youth, Adult Horsemanship/Equitation, & Showmanship where the points are awarded to the individual, and Adult Amateur where the points are awarded to a single individual/horse combination.

Examples:

5 Horse Class

| Place | Points |

Championships

| Place | Points |

| Reserve | 8 |

| 5 th | 2 |

Dressage/SHIH

| Score % | Points |
|---------|--------|
| 80%+ | 5 |
| 70-79% | 4 |
| 65-69% | 3 |
| 60-64% | 2 |
| 50-59% | 1 |

Championship points are awarded in Rated/Class A and Rated/Class A Amateur **ONLY**. In the event that a Rated/Class A show also qualifies as a Local Circuit show (i.e. – **American Royal Arabian Show, Boarder Bonanza**), championship points will **NOT** be awarded in the Local Circuit division.

Endurance/Competitive Trail Points

| # Of Horses | 1 st | 2 nd | 3 rd | 4 th | 5 th |
|-------------|-----------------|-----------------|-----------------|-----------------|-----------------|
| 2-3 | 1 | | | | |
| 4-7 | 2 | 1 | | | |
| 8-11 | 3 | 2 | 1 | | |
| 12-15 | 4 | 3 | 2 | 1 | |
| 16-19 | 5 | 4 | 3 | 2 | 1 |
| 20+ | 6 | 5 | 4 | 3 | 2 |

Best condition receives an additional 6 points

Completion of the ride receives an additional 4 points

Total points received are determined by the placing **AND** distance. To comply with AHA, points are multiplied by the number of miles of the ride in percentage form.

Example: A 1st place in a 50 mile ride of 20 horses would give you 6 points. Your 6 points would then be 50% (0.50) to give you an additional 3 points (9 points total for that ride). You would also get 4 points for completion of the ride as well as 6 points for best of condition if that applied. **Grand total possible for this example is 19.**
